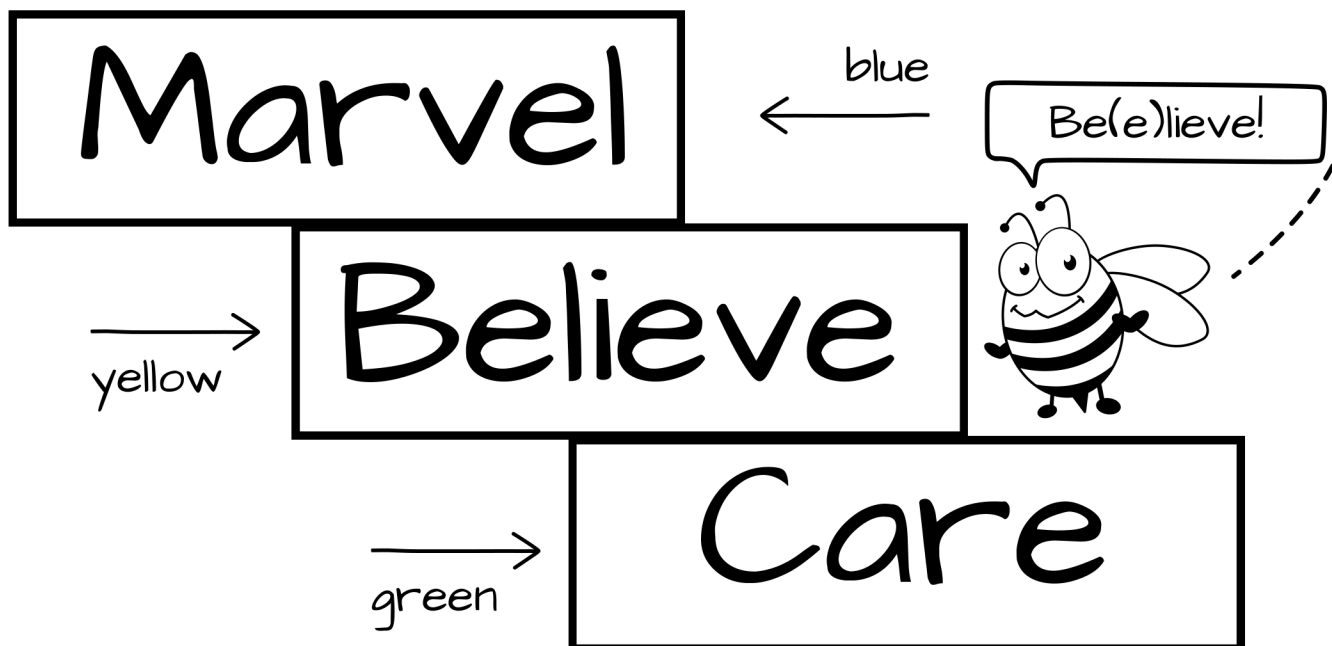


The Marvel, Believe, Care series offers children activities to explore and delight in creation through the traditions of the Catholic Church.

BLUE: Look to the skies, to the seas; marvel at what God has made.

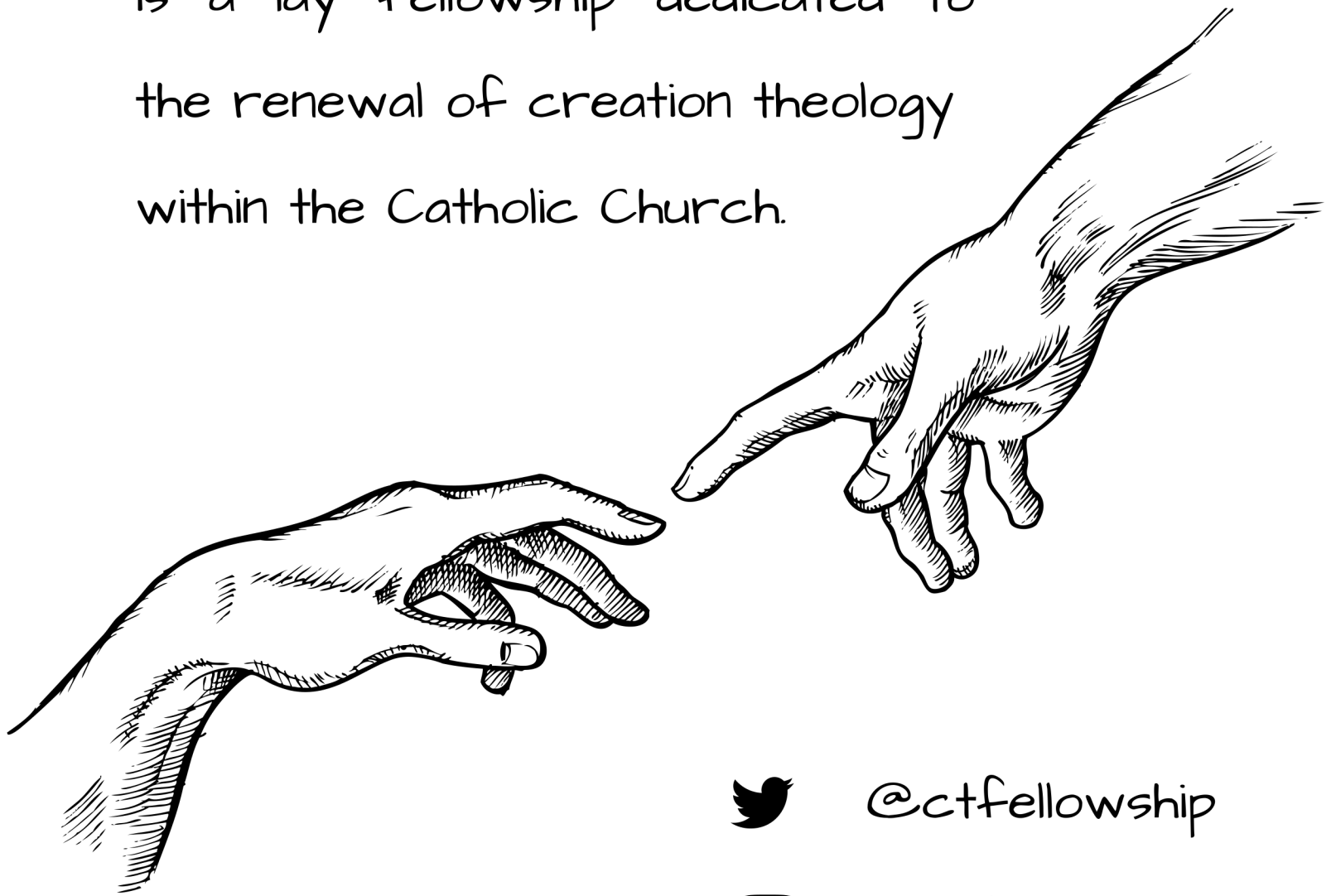
YELLOW: Through God's grace, we believe; the light of faith shines as we marvel and care.
